Bozeman Brewing Plum St. Porter A Bozeman Brewing original. Medium bodied with a beautiful, complex roast. Not too dark. Just right. Bozeman, MT ABV 5.8% (12oz) 5

Meadowlark Teddy Roosevelt American Badass Imperial Wheat IPA aged on Oak. An incredible beer to commemorate an incredible President. A great combination of Imperial Wheat and barrel aging. Sydney, MT ABV 6.9% (16oz) 8

Madison River Juice Double IPA This double IPA has everything you want in an IPA. It's hoppy, juicy, and full bodied. It's one of those beers that dangerously delicious. Belgrade, MT ABV 9% (12oz) 7

Big Sky IPA A true Missoula classic. Amber in Hue with a full body. Hoppy yet still very smooth. Missoula, MT ABV 6.2% (12oz) 6

Madison River Salmon Fly Honey Rye A very well balanced beer for all types of beer drinkers. The spiciness of the malted Barley is evened out with the smoothness of local Montana Honey. Belgrade, MT ABV 5.6% (12oz) 6

Meadowlark Brewing Ole' Gus Scottish Ale Full-bodied with robust caramel malt notes, this ale features a slight crispness married to subtle fruity esters from Edinburgh ale yeast. Sydney, MT ABV 7% (12oz) 5

Classic and Experimental Belgian Ales

New Belgium + De Konick Flowering Citrus Ale A floral and citrusy ale. Golden in color with notes of Hibiscus, Lemon, and Key Lime. A great daytime or evening drink. Brewed in collaboration with De Konick of Belgium using Antwerp. Fort Collins, CO ABV 7.4% (12oz) 5.5

Upslope Blood Orange Saison A refreshing take on the classic Belgian Saison style. The fruit added is well balanced. Not overly sweet, but prominent enough to compliment the Belgian yeast. This beer is fantastic. Boulder, CO ABV 6% (12oz) 5

St. Bernardus Tripel A Belgian gem. Full bodied with a beautiful floral aroma. This beer is meant to be enjoyed and appreciated. Brouwerij St. Bernardus, Belgium ABV 8% (12oz) 8

St. Bernardus Abt 12 A pride of Belgian Beer. This Belgian Quad is a heavy hitter with a delicate mouthfeel. It has a long bittersweet finish with a light hop finish. Watau, Belgium ABV 10.8% (11.2oz) 8

Piraat Ale Caramel Brown in color. IPA in aroma. Belgian dark ale in flavor. Try this with the lamb burger. (330ml) 8

Unibroue Maudite Strong Red ale A robust malty beer. A spicy nose that is counterbalanced by an assertive crisp hop finish. Great with cheese and meat. Chambly, Canada ABV 9% (12 oz) 8

IPAs, Pale Ales and American Style Ales

Caldera Ashland Amber An award winning gem. Caldera's pride and joy. Full bodied and ultra smooth. Start your evening here. Ashland, OR ABV 5.6% (12oz) 6

Black Diamond Brewing White Witch IPA Citrus and pine notes with a delicious underlying malt sweetness. Concord, CA ABV 6.3% (12oz) 6

Caldera Hopportunity Knocks This IPA is a showcase of skill. It is a perfectly balanced hoppy brew. Hints of Pine and wild flowers. Ashland, OR ABV 6.8% (12oz) 6

Iron Horse Koytus Hoppy Oat Ale Hop, meet Oat. Oat, meet hop. They met in this bottle and the relationship has flourished into an awesome beer. Super smooth from the Oats with a little fruit at the end from the Hops. Ellensburg, WA ABV 5.4% (22oz) 12

Ballast Point Coffee Cream Ale Brewed with coffee and vanilla, this cream ale is one never to be forgotten. It goes well with breakfast, lunch, dinner, and dessert. Super smooth and approachable. San Diego, CA ABV 5.5% (12oz) 7

Ommegang Rare Vos Amber Ale Brewed as a traditional Belgian cafe style beer. MEant to be drank in the afternoon or early evening. Balanced yet complex. Cooperstown, NY ABC 6.5% (12oz) 6

MOA Five Hop Winter Ale Balanced and fresh. An impeccable winter ale. Beautiful and cozy. Marlborough, NZ ABV 6.2% (12.7 oz) 10

Thornbridge - Jaipur IPA. A citrus dominated India Pale Ale. Soft and smooth yet builds to a crescendo of massive hoppiness accentuated by honey. An enduring, bitter finish. Bakewell, England ABV 6.6% (16.9 oz) 13

Sours, Lambics, Krieks and Heritage styles

Wittekerke Wild An awesome ale brewed with wild yeast and bacteria. A crisp refreshing slightly sour beer. Sessionable and approachable. A great Wit beer for this time of year. Brouwerij De Brabandere, Belgium ABV 5.1% (16oz) 8

De Troch Oude Gueze A classic Belgian sour. However, not as tart by today's standards. This is a true Belgian Gueze. Its made by blending 1 and 2 year lambics. A very refreshing sour. Wambeek, Belgium 5.5%ABV (11.2oz) 8

Gasthaus Leipziger Gose A legend around the world. This old world style brew is brewed with salt, but just below the amount we can actually taste. Gose's were thought to be a lost style, until its revitalization in recent years. Leipzig, Germany ABV 4.6% (11.2) 8

Vichtenaar Flemish Ale A traditional red. A great balance between sweet and sour. Brouwerij Verhaeghe, Belgium. ABV 5.1% (11.2oz) 9

Duchesse de Bourgogne One of the world's best Flemish style red ales. Matured in oak with extreme care. Top Fermentation. A masterpiece. Brouwerij Verhaeghe, Belgium. ABV 6% (11.2oz) 10

Barbe Kriek Cherry Ale Slightly Sour. Cherry. Balance. Begs to be drank alongside a plate of cheese and meats. Brouwerij Verhaeghe, Belgium. ABV 7.7% (11.2oz) 10

Echt Kriekenbier This is like drinking a delicious Manhattan, only it's a beer. Brouwerij Verhaeghe, Belgium. ABV 6.8% (11.2oz) 10

Ommegang Rosetta a homage to time-honored Belgian methods of aging and blending fruit beers. It offers elegance, depth, complexity, and an intriguing interplay of tartness and sweetness. ABV 5.6% (12oz) 8

Lagunitas Aunt Sally Sour soured the wort on the Hot Side with Lactobacillus for a few days and then brewed up this smooth and hoppy sour. It tastes like a big bowl of fruity candy or some chewable flavored vitamins, but what's the difference? It's sweet, tart, and sassy, just like the tasty cherry pie that your favorite aunt makes. Petaluma, CA ABV 5.7% (12oz) 5

Pilsner and German Style Ale

Weihenstephaner Vitus The fruity smell of dried apricots joins aromas of citrus, cloves and hints of banana. Full-bodied and sparkling with an effervescent mouthfeel. Great with Red Meat, strong cheeses, and dessert. Freising, Germany ABV 7.7% (16.9oz) 7

Schwaben Brau Unfiltered Pilsner Unlike traditional German pilsners this is a unfiltered full bodied bold pils. Most traditional Pilsners are filtered many times, but this is true to it's roots. Stuttgart, Germany ABV 5% (16oz) 6

Praga Pilsner Exactly what you would expect from a Czech Pils! Balanced malty character with a slight grain sweetness, very approachable. České Budějovice, Czech Republic ABV 4.5% (11.2 oz) 6

Ciders

Altazueta Sidra Natural Cider A Basque classic. Bracing. Crisp. Thirst-Quenching. Hernani, SP ABV 6% (750ml) 15

Montana Ciderworks North Fork Tradition A semi-dry English style. Compelling and earthy. Darby, MT ABV 7% (16 oz) 16

Montana Ciderworks McIntosh Cider A touch sweet, a touch tart. A real small farm, farmer's cider in the old European style. Made only of McIntosh apples from the Bitterroot! Fantastic. Fermented and bottled just down the road in Darby, Montana ABV 6.0% (17oz) 16

Montana Ciderworks Spartan Dry Cider The Gem of Apples grown in the Bitterroot Valley. Single-varietal and very rare, this cider is reminiscent of an Italian Sauvignon Blanc. Crisp and piercingly clean. A magnificent cider. Darby, MT ABV 6.0% (17oz) 16

Wandering Aengus Wickson Crab Apple Cider Ah! Magic! An heirloom, single-varietal cider with character and interest. Beautiful floral aromas and a striking tartness. Salem, OR ABV 7.7% (16.9 oz) 15

Wandering Aengus Golden Russet Cider A delicious single varietal cider. Dry but laced with complex notes of honey and sun and texture. Salem, OR ABV 9.8% (16.9 oz) 15

Daufresne Brut Cidre Finesse and Freshness compliment the aromas of ripe apples and spices. A perfectly balanced cider. Made from a variety of apple in the Normandy region of France. Pairs incredibly with the Tre Contorni. Normandy, France ABV 5% (750ml) 15

English style Ales, Porters, and Stouts

D. Carnegie & Co. Porter During the first and second World Wars, strong ale was banned in Sweden to save resources. This beer has been slightly modified since its 1836 inauguration, but stays true to its old school Porter taste. 100% on Beer Advocate. Goteborg, Sweden ABV 5.5% (11.2) 9

Bozeman Brewing Plum St. Porter A Bozeman Brewing original. Medium bodied with a beautiful, complex roast. Not too dark. Just right. Bozeman, MT ABV 5.8% (12oz) 5

Young's Double Chocolate Stout A classic stout style ale. Heavy Chocolate and coffee on the nose with a surprisingly light mouth-feel. Sweet and smooth. A Luxurious stout with hints of decadence. Bedford, UK ABV 5.2% (16oz) 6

Orkney Skull Splitter A legend of Scotch-style beer. Robust and Rich with a slight sweetness. One of the worlds best 'Wee-Heavy' style beers. Quoyloo, UK ABV 8.5% (11.2oz) 6

Stone Brewing Xocoveza Imperial Spiced Mocha Stout - This simply tastes like the holidays. Get Cozy and settle in to this rich, festive brew. (12oz) 6

Iron Horse Irish Death It's hard to classify this beer. While one would think its a scotch ale, it also has the smoothness of a stout. Iron Horse calls it a dark smooth ale. Smooth right from the start with a sweet cocoa like finish. Ellensburg, WA ABV 7.8% (12oz) 5

Harviestoun Ola Dubh 16 year Whiskey lovers rejoice. This elegant Scottish ale aged in Highland Park 16 year Whiskey casks is complex, but not overbearing. We are lucky to have this beer on our shelves. Alva, Scotland ABV 8% (11oz) 14

Northcoast Old Rasputin Imperial Stout Rich, Bold, and Moving. this legendary Russian Stout is sure to hit the spot of anyone craving a big, full bodied brew. Fort Bragg, CA ABV 9% (12oz) 8

Cellar Selections

Kasteel Trignac 2013 A beautiful Belgian Trippel aged in Cognac Casks. Limited Numbered production of 30,000. A special beer indeed. This beer is medium bodied with a very complex taste. Enjoy as a celebration beer or just a great beer to share with friends! Ingelmunster, Belgium ABV 12% (750ml) 25

Deschutes Pinot Suave An incredibly unique Belgian style with notes of Pinot grapes, berry juice, and light malt with caramel flavors. Barrel aged for 18 months in French and American Oak barrels that previously held Pinot grapes. Bend, Oregon ABV 11.8% (650ml) 18

Saison Dupont Cuvee Dry Hopping 2015 A true legend of Belgium. This beer is considered to be the epitome of Belgian Saisons. However, in 2015 the brewery released a Dry Hopped edition. The addition of hops adds an even brighter and fresher taste. This is a bucket list beer. Tourpes, Belgium ABV 6.5% (750ml) 17

Selkirk Abbey Cuvee de la Nuit Profonde A Barrel aged Dark Ale that really shows what barrel aging can do to an ale. Dark and deep in color and taste. If you enjoy barrel aged beer, this is the beer for you. Post Falls, Idaho ABV 9% (650ml) 17

Selkirk Abbey Imperial Saison Limited production of 2,000 bottles in 2014 ; we decided to age a case of these for over two years. Lighter in Color, full in taste. This Farmhouse style ale has Munich malts that have transformed beautifully over the years. Be one of the luck ones. Post Falls, Idaho ABV 9.2% (22oz) 22

Deschutes 2014 Abyss The legend continues. Aged for 2 years. This beer has depth and complexities that will blow you away. Bend, OR ABV 11.8% (650ml) 28

Deschutes 2014 Dissident 35% Aged in Oak, 65% brewed with cherries. Aged for over 2 years. A Flanders style sour brown ale that is sure to please any beer fan. Bend, OR ABV 10.7% (22oz) 25
